The National theme for Reconciliation Week 2013 is: *Let's Talk Recognition.*

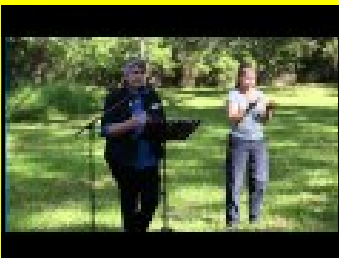
The theme is about the need to recognise Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in the Australian Constitution.
